EXHIBITOR'S DEFINITIONS, ABBREVIATIONS & AGE:

Traditional Exhibitor (TR Exh; Division 1):

Defined is a person who CAN meet the AKC'S traditional
canine competition handling standards of one handler with
one canine and does not require the assistance of a Team
Instructor in the canine judging ring. **Participation**
Eligibility – To be eligible to participate in the Rally, Jr.
Handling and Traditional Canine Event(s), the TR Exh must
be between the ages of 5 to 20 years of age as of January 1st
of current year.

**Non-Traditional Exhibitor (NTR Exh; special needs;
Divisions 1 & 2):**

Defined is a person who CANNOT meet the AKC'S
traditional canine competition handling standards of one
handler with one canine and does require the assistance of a
Team Instructor in the canine judging ring. **Participation**
Eligibility – To be eligible to participate in the Rally, Jr.
NTR Handling and Non-Traditional Canine Event(s), the
NTR Exh. must be between the ages of 5 to 26 years of age
as of January 1st of current year. NTR Exh. must have
trained with a Berrien County 4-H Canine Therapy Dog

Competition Club, OR a dog training facility that offers
Canine Therapy Dog Competition classes.

** The term “*inclusive*” shall be understood as both TR
and NTR exhibitors entering and including competing in
same event and/or classes.

** Exhibitor's Responsibility –EXHIBITOR IS
RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING AND READING THE
COMPLETE DOG EVENT(S) JUDGING PROGRAM(S) AND
GUIDELINE(S) BEFORE EXHIBITING IN HIS OR HER CHOSEN
CANINE EVENT(S). Dog Event judging programs and
guidelines can be obtained from the BCYF main office, or
go to www.bf4hclub.com, and Michigan State University
Extension Office.

BCYF DOG DEPARTMENT REGISTRATION AND GENERAL RULES:

- 1: Registration Deadline - DOG EVENT(S) REGISTRATION
DEADLINE IS JULY 1ST. LATE REGISTRATION AND/OR
CANINE PHOTOGRAPHS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER
JULY 1ST. IF DONE ON LINE, STILL NEED TO SEND JULY 1ST!
- 2: Canine Photographs – Two (2) current photographs of
your dog entered must accompany the Exhibitor's
registration. One photograph must show a front view of the
dog, and the second photograph must show a side view of
the dog. EACH PHOTOGRAPH SHALL BE LABELED WITH
THE EXHIBITOR'S BCYF ID NUMBER, DOG'S NAME, AGE,
BREED, SEX, AND IF ALTERED OR NOT. Photographs become
the property of the BCYF and will not be returned.
- 3: Canine Event Judging - Canine Event classes may be
held in reverse Exhibitor Handbook order should the judge
deem it necessary. **JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL.**
- 4: TR AND NTR Class Advancement – Please read the Dog
Event judging programs and guidelines. *Refer to exhibitor's
responsibilities.*
- 5: Canine Event's Exhibitor's Dress Code, Canine
Grooming Code & Sportsmanship Code of Conduct
WILL BE ENFORCED. See dog events judging programs and
guidelines.
- 5: Parking – Using Gate 2, please drive up to the Dog and
Cat Tent, unload your dog equipment, and then park your
car in proper area.

BCYF CANINE REGULATIONS

- 1: Major Exhibits - TR and NTR Obedience, Agility, Rally
and Junior Handling are major exhibits. Animal Science
Notebooks and Costume Event are not major exhibits.
- 2: Canine Ownership – TR Exh dog(s) must be owned by
the Exhibitor, his/her parent, guardian or immediate family
member. TR Exhibitor shall care for and train the dog(s).
NTR Exhibitor may own the dog, or may register a
Volunteer Team Dog with whom he/she has been training
with, along with a Team Instructor, for at least eight (8)
weeks prior to exhibition. *Refer to the NTR OB and NTR AG
Judging Rules and Regulations.*
- 3: Canine's Age – TR and NTR Exhibitor's canine must be
six (6) months of age as of August 1st of current year to be
entered in Obedience, Rally, Junior Handling and Costume.
For Agility Events - TR Exhibitor's canine must be twelve

(12) months of age, and NTR Exhibitor's canine must be six (6) months of age.

4: Sharing Canine(s) - Sharing of a canine in the same event and/or class is prohibited.

5: How Many Dogs Can Exhibitor Enter? –

- A. **TR Exhibitor may enter a maximum** of two (2) dogs in the dog events of Obedience, Rally and Agility. **Exceptions are OB Pre Beginner A and Agility Young Beginner's Class** where the exhibitor may enter only one canine in these event classes. TR exhibitor may enter one dog in Junior Handling and Costume.
- B. **NTR exhibitor may enter** one (1) canine in Nontraditional Dog Events of Obedience, Agility, Rally, Junior Showmanship and Costume, but may use a **registered** Reserve Canine should the need arise according to the NTR OB, RA and AG Judging Program and Guidelines.

6: Canine with a Title – TR exhibitor's canine with an Obedience, Agility and/or Rally title, and showing proof of said title, must show in the next higher class than the title.

7: Handicap Canine – A canine with a life challenge will be permitted to compete in dog event classes, but is required to perform all parts of the exercises without added assistance from the exhibitor.

8: Canine Immunizations – As of March 1, 2022 all canine vaccinations must be administered by a licensed veterinarian and valid proof (signed certificate) from veterinarian must be provided on Entry Day. Exception to this ruling will be if the canine immunizations were administered by someone other than a licensed veterinarian (excluding rabies) prior to March 1st 2022 and the canine is not due for the next immunizations for 3 years from the date administered. The exhibitor must show valid proof of the date of injections, the label, sticker, or the bottle itself of the vaccine on Entry Day. Canine, regardless of age, is required to have received the following immunizations: Rabies, Distemper, Hepatitis and Parvovirus. On Entry Day the exhibitor must provide a rabies certificate, as well as a DHP certificate (unless exempt by the March 1st, 2022 ruling) signed by a licensed veterinarian as proof that canine received said immunizations. One-year (1) vaccinations for a canine, ages six (6) months to eighteen (18) months, is acceptable if administered on or before July first (1st). For canine that is nineteen (19) months and older, three (3) year immunizations are acceptable if administered on or before July first (1st). Bordetella, Influenza, Lyme's, and Leptospirosis are recommended but optional.

9: Canine May Not Participate – Pregnant canine, obese canine, or a canine in poor health may not participate in BCYF's Dog Department events. A canine with a physical or mental condition that would significantly impair the dog's performance, may not participate. Examples including, but not limited to, hip dysplasia, disc problems, severely slipped stifles, shoulder problems, overweight or advancing age. If noted later that a canine should not have participated due to the restrictions mentioned, the exhibitor will be disqualified and premiums, ribbons and awards will be withdrawn. Judges, veterinarian, fair board member(s), and or Dog Committee Member(s) reserve the right to inspect and/or

disqualify any and/or all canines for health, disposition, temperament, etc.

10: Veterinarian Health Check – Unless mandated by the State of Michigan, each canine will require one (1) mandatory veterinarian health check for the entire week of the fair. Veterinarian health checks shall be done one (1) hour prior to the first event of the day. **If fleas have been found on the canine, the exhibitor must provide CAPSTAR to be administered immediately. Otherwise there will not be a veterinarian health clearance, and said canine goes home.** Exhibitor may not pick up his/her back tag number until proof of a veterinarian health check has been issued by the veterinarian.

11: Canine Grooming Code – Canine shall be judged on its grooming. Canine shall be immaculately groomed to breed standards, or to the breed standards the canine closest resembles. This will include the ears and eyes cleaned and no foul odor emitting from ears. Teeth brushed and paws and nails trimmed. Should the exhibitor choose not to groom his or her canine, he or she will be penalized up to minus (-) sixty (60) points.

12: Canine in Season – Exhibitor will communicate that his/her canine is in season to the Registrar when picking up his or her BCYF's back tag number. **Said canine will wear Bloomers (doggie panties) with an absorbent pad adhered to the inside.** Canine will be isolated from all other canines and will be shown out of judging order by being last in the event judging ring.

13: Canine Supervision, Boundaries and Safety – Canine must be removed from the fairgrounds upon the completion of dog events each day. Unless the canine is a Service Dog, canine(s) are not allowed beyond the fairground gate, or beyond the Green Parking Lot boundaries by Gate 2. Canine must remain on a leash or crated safely. If crated, the crate shall be labeled with the exhibitor's name, exhibitor number, and immediate phone number. Canine is not allowed on the bleachers nor in the bleacher area. Please keep canines six to eight feet apart to prevent dog fights and/or human injury.

SUNDAY, ENTRY DAY –

1: Purpose: To verify exhibitor's canine event classes and canine's immunizations. At this time exhibitor may drop, change, add classes, or cancel a canine's participation. New canine(s) may not be added or registered. Exhibitor may register for High Point Dog Exhibitor(s) Awards and Ag Olympics.

ITEMS TO BRING: A copy of your canine's classes entered, proof of canine's immunizations, and you must complete and sign a BCYF Animal Certification Form at this time.

2: Award Registration - TR exhibitor may sign up for the following Overall Event Championship awards:

TR Overall Junior Dog Exhibitor Award –

Rules - Exhibitors, ages 5 to 9 years, are required to sign up for this award. Exh. must be entered, and will have competed in Obedience, Junior Handling, Agility and Rally. Winners are selected on a point system based on where he/she places in the named events.
