## Helpful Ideas:

Re-sale means the animal will usually be bought by an area auction barn at Market Price. When you check-out at the payment table, you will only need to pay the difference between the purchase price and the posted market price.

Some buyers come to the auction to buy animals for the publicity only, and this is where the re-sale option comes into play.

One of the advantages to re-sale is that the **DIFFERENCE** between the purchase price and market price may be tax deductible.

Example: 1000# steer @ \$1.70/lb. = \$1.700.00 Market price is \$.69 /lb x 1000 lb = \$690.00 Total to be paid by livestock buyer is \$1,010.00

### This is how it works!

## STEP 1:

SMALL ANIMAL AUCTION:

 Stop at the Buyer Registration Table located under the tent between buildings 10 & 11 and receive your buyer number.

LARGE ANIMAL AUCTION:

- Stop by the Buyer Registration Table located just inside the door of the Show Arena & receive your buyer number.
- After you have received your buyer number, you may wish to pick up a "Sale Bill" which will list the order in which the animals will be auctioned. This sale bill also lists the name and town of the exhibitor who is showing the animal.

#### SALE BILLS ONLINE! The night before the auctions, the sale bills will be available online at

www.bcyf.org – print off your own copy ahead of time to help you plan your day at the auction.

## PHONE:

You must supply a home phone number when you register as a buyer.

## STEP 2:

Once you are registered and have your buyer number, find a seat and get ready to bid!

## STEP 3:

When the first animal is presented for auction, the bidding will begin. All you have to do to bid is nod your head, raise your hand, raise your bidders paddle, stand up...anything to get the attention of the bid taker that will be walking/standing in front of the bleachers. Chickens, Turkeys, Rabbits & Goats are sold by the head. All others are sold at a price per pound.

## STEP 4:

- When the auctioneer announces that the animal is sold and your bid was the highest, then you have just become the proud owner of that animal. Now you have some decisions to make regarding the Final Destination of your animal.
- After you have made all your purchases, proceed to the buyers payment table located near the buyer registration area. They will give you a form to fill out; you will need to "designate" where the final destination will be. Your options are: a Re-Sale Buyer, one of the listed Processors, or for buyer pick-up. It is extremely important that you designate where the animal should go.

An auction official will add up your purchases and you will be required to make <u>FULL Payment</u> at that time.

## CASH or CHECK

Attention Buyers: for a 3% time/price differential charge, you may defer immediate payment and use a credit card
