- A. All Beef classes are major exhibits.
- B. An exhibitor may exhibit 2 entries in each beef breeding class, but no more than two market animals.
- **C.** Market animals must be weighed on beef scales prior to assignment of the stalls on entry day.
- D. All beef females, Hereford, Angus, Simmental, Shorthorn, Chianina and Any Other Registered Breed are to be registered. Commercial breed females are exempt. Commercial breed females should be at least 50% beef breeding.
- E. Scurs are acceptable, horns no more than 2 inches. Final judgement made by beef committee.
- F. Final decision of class for any animal in question will be decided upon by the beef barn superintendent(s) and Assistant Superintendent(s), the beef committee chairman, and youth exhibit coordinator in conjunction with Fair Board rules and regulations any time prior to close of entry day.

- G. Each animal shall be double tied with a halter and a neck tie while in the barn.
- H. Any heifer shown in market class must be open, guaranteed not bred.
- A market heifer registered by February 1<sup>st</sup> may be changed to a breeding heifer class at June registration. Animal may only show in one class.
- Animals tagged at weigh in may only be exhibited by that exhibitor.
- K. All beef market animals must be registered in <u>the</u> <u>correct class at weigh in time</u>. Crossbred animals; Exhibitor should know the breeds of the Cross.
- L Breed steers do not require registration papers. However, breed characteristic must be followed in accordance with their national breed registry that corresponds with the breed class entered on entry forms. Any breed steer that is deemed non-compliant due to breed characteristics will automatically be placed in the crossbred market steer class. Breed verification will take place either at weigh-in or prior to 4 p.m. on entry day. NOTE: All Angus market animals must be polled (no scurs). Angus that are found to have scurs, even if the exhibitor has registration papers, will be moved to the crossbred division.
- M. If there are no participants in a market beef breed class for two consecutive years, the class will be eliminated.
- N. Small rosettes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in market weight, Beef Breeding and feeder calf classes.
- O. All Beef Breeding female livestock must be owned by a breeder residing in Berrien County, and **exhibitor must** have done at least 50% of the care.
- P. Exhibitors having registered breeding stock must bring their registration papers to the weigh-in area <u>during</u> weigh-in hours on Sunday of Fair for breed verification.
- Q. Any animal shown in a Showmanship class <u>MUST</u> be entered by the exhibitor showing the animal.
- R. Refer to www.michigan.gov/mdard for complete official ID rules and MDARD Health Rules also available in office.
- S. Exhibitor must be present during judging of Champion class to be eligible to win.
- T. No grooming chutes allowed in barn before 4:00 a.m. show day and removed from barn 1 hour after show.

# **BEEF FEEDER CALVES**

### General Rules:

- 1. The exhibitor must own all calves no later than June 1<sup>st</sup> of current year.
- 2. Calf must be born between Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> & June 1<sup>st</sup> of current yr. Dairy Feeder calves may be born Nov 1<sup>st</sup> of previous year thru June 1<sup>st</sup> of current year.
- 3. Only steer calves may be shown, no bull or heifer calves. A calf may still be nursing ONLY if the cow is also entered and exhibited in the beef breeding division. All other calves must be weaned.
- 4. All calves must be de-horned.
- 5. Calves are required to have an RFID tag & comply with all State & Federal Health regulations. See www.michigan.gov/mda or available in office.
- 6. No min. or max. weight requirement for calves.
- 7. Calves will be shown according to weight.
- 7. Feeder calves are not eligible to be auctioned.

- 1. Class Minimum 2 beef, maximum of 10 beef due to limited space, in such an event if more than 10 beef are registered, BCYF Beef Chairman and Fair Manager will conduct a lottery drawing and inform the Exhibitors of chosen participants.
- 2. Only ONE tagged Beef will be allowed per Exhibitor at weigh in for Beef Carcass class.
- 3. If you have tagged at the Feb. weigh-in both a carcass beef and a Mkt beef (steer or Mkt Heifer) you will be allowed to switch the two around, either carcass to market or market beef to carcass. If you switch the carcass beef to market it will be shown as either a Crossbred steer, Market Heifer or Dairy. Not in any other breed class. Notify Fair Office by July 1.
- 4. Exhibitor is responsible for the processing fees and must have processing sheets filled out before end of Live show. Exhibitor is expected to take their own meat or have a buyer lined up to take it.
- 5. Only Champion and Reserve Champion Beef Carcass will be allowed to sell in the Large Animal Aucton and will be sold AS LIVE WEIGHT only. Exhibitor MUST be present at the Auction of their animal. Champion and Reserve will be determined the night of the Carcass evaluation.
- 6. Live show will take place at 5:30 p.m. at the BCYF wash rack. Exhibitor can use the beef barn wash rack to wash beef and groom. Grooming chutes are allowed to groom the animal and chutes are expected to be removed by end of the LIVE show. Beef is expected to be clipped prior to and not the day of show at the fair. Exhibitor must present and show their own beef.
- 7. Exhibitor will be responsible for their own transportation to both evaluations.
- 8. Exhibitor must wear appropriate clothing/shoes at **BOTH** evaluations. Jeans, button down shirt and boots are proper attire, anything else is not acceptable. No hats allowed
- After completion of LIVE show all Beef will be loaded out and shipped to Martin's for slaughter, then prepared for hanging BEEF Carcass Evaluation show. BCYF will provide trucking to this location. NO private loads will be allowed.
