## **CONTEST RULES**

- Recipes cannot include mixes or canned fillings. No whipped topping is allowed (no Cool Whip, no Whipped Cream). No cream filling of any type is allowed (no cream pies, no custard pies). Pies should <u>not</u> have to be refrigerated. Crust must be made from scratch. Homemade glaze is allowed. No alcohol allowed. <u>Must use</u> locally grown fruit only.
- 2. No commercial bakers may enter the contest.
- 3. Each contestant may enter no more than two pies. Contestants of the same family can not enter identical recipes, in either age division.
- No recipe changes following submission of original "Entry Form." Pies with a variance in recipe will be disqualified. Recipes <u>must</u> be handwritten or typed. Photocopies from cookbooks will be disqualified.
- 5. Contestants must be residents of Berrien County and/or be in compliance with BCYF exhibitor rules.
- 6. Pies must be submitted in disposable pie plates <u>only</u>.
- 7. Ribbons will be awarded to the top five placing contestants in each age group, with trophies, ribbons, and/or prizes going to 1<sup>st</sup> place champions and "Most Eye Appealing" winner.
- 8. A special "I Love Pie" award and \$25 cash prize will be awarded to a deserving participant.
- 9. It is preferred that winners be present to receive awards, which will be awarded at approximately noon. Following award presentations, the public will be invited to sample the entries.
- 10. Judges' decisions are final. Participants agree to have their name and recipe released to the media.
