Points will be counted across all shows in the series. All high point contenders **must first pay their \$10 fee prior to tracking points!** Only points earned AFTER this fee has been paid will be counted towards a rider's total. High point winners will be announced after the last class on July 26.

In the event of a tie, the rider with the most 1st places will break the tie. If there is still a tie, a horse knowledge question will be asked by the judge.
