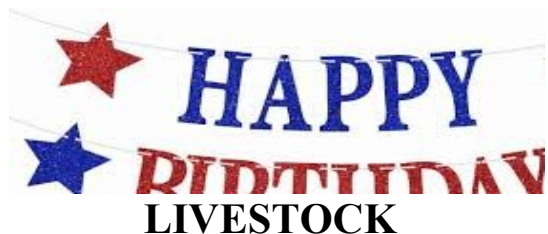

### OFFICIAL IDENTIFICATION FOR GOATS

#### Information received from MDARD (01/24)

Must have official USDA Scrapie identification tag - Tag Hotline (517) 337-4705. (Individuals can tattoo the scrapie tag number in the goats ear, (except Market goat) tail web or flank, but must make the tag unusable and legible, and carry the tag with the animal when moved.) **OR** Registered breed tattoo or microchip accompanied by breed registration papers (**must be presented with registration**) or if online, downloaded with registration on June 1st.

\*If you are registering with a microchip number, you must provide your own scanner during the week of the fair if needed.

**Registration Deadline: June 1, 2026**

**Market Ear Tags in by: June 4, 2026**

**Market Ear Tags: All Market goats (including back-ups) must be brought to the fairgrounds for tagging on June 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. If unable to attend on either date, exhibitor must notify superintendent no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>. All sheep must have ear tag in place by June 4<sup>th</sup>. Photos of all market animals will also be taken at time of tagging.**

**All Goats must be verified to the Superintendent by July 17<sup>th</sup>! (How many goats you will be bringing)**

- A. All Goat classes are major exhibits.
- B. Exhibitor allowed one entry in each breed class.
- C. An animal must show in a breed class (Pygmy, Dairy, Any Other Breed, Myotonics, Boer, Pet Wether, or Market) to be eligible to show in Showmanship, Obstacle, Costume, or Cart Class.
- D. All valid registrations must include the permanent Tattoo (as listed on registration papers) or Scrapie # entered in the online registration system or on Entry Form **at time of Registration.**
- E. No bucks except nursing kids under 8 weeks permitted.
- F. No horns or scurs over 1" long allowed except for Angora, Boer and Myotonics breeding stock and Market Boer Does- **NO horns allowed on wethers or dairy market projects. Exhibitors with horned animals must provide additional fencing to ensure animal safety.**
- G. It is recommended that all goats be vaccinated for Enterotoxemia.
- H. The age of the animal is determined by the date of the show.
- I. All market goats will use market ear tags. LaManchas may have tag on collar.
- J. Any full body clipping must be completed prior to entry day of the BCYF.
- K. All male market goats must be surgically castrated or banded. No wethers with male characteristics in Rut permitted.
- L. **Any goat that has evidence of lice will be dismissed along with any other animals on the same trailer.**
- M. All does in breed classes must be entered in what they most closely represent.
- N. Total number of Goats must be verified too the *Superintendents* by **July 17<sup>th</sup>**, or no pens will be

assigned.

- O. **Goat Committee reserves the right to make final decisions.**
- P. Exhibitor must be present during Champion class to be eligible to win.
- Q. Drenching of goats is prohibited without Superintendent and Veterinarian approval.
- R. All Goats must stay in goat barn/tent or wash rack area by Wonders of Birth unless going to the show arena.
